### LIST OF APPROPRIATE TOLLS PAYABLE IN 2014

Direction of Travel	Toll Charges for 2014
Southbound (Santry to Dublin Port)	<b>€10.00</b> between 6.00 am to 10.00 am, Monday to Friday <b>€3.00</b> at all other times and on public holidays.
Northbound (Dublin Port to Santry)	<b>€10.00</b> between 4.00 pm to 7.00 pm, Monday to Friday <b>€3.00</b> at all other times and on public holidays.

*The tolls are inclusive of VAT at the standard rate (currently 23%).  
VAT registered road users can reclaim VAT paid on tolls.*

The Appropriate Tolls are the tolls that will apply to non-exempt vehicles with effect from 1st January 2014. Goods Vehicles with a design gross vehicle weight exceeding 3,500 kilograms and buses with more than 25 seats are exempt from tolls. Further information on the tolling arrangements is set out in the Dublin Port Tunnel Toll Bye-Laws, copies of which may be downloaded from the NRA's website ([www.nra.ie](http://www.nra.ie)).

### MAXIMUM TOLLS

In accordance with the Bye-Laws for the Dublin Port Tunnel, the NRA is obliged to publish details of Maximum Tolls as defined in the Bye-Laws. The calculated Maximum Tolls for 2014 are as follows:

Northbound	Monday to Friday	4 pm to 7 pm	<b>€13.50</b>
Northbound	Monday to Friday	7 pm to 10 pm	<b>€6.50</b>
Northbound and Southbound	Saturday and Sunday	6 am to 10 pm	<b>€6.50</b>
Northbound and Southbound	Monday to Sunday	All times other than 6 am to 10 pm	<b>€3.50</b>
