### LIST OF APPROPRIATE TOLLS PAYABLE IN 2023

The Appropriate Tolls are the tolls that will apply to non-exempt vehicles with effect from 1st January 2023. Goods Vehicles with a design gross vehicle weight exceeding 3,500 kilograms and buses with more than 25 seats are exempt from tolls. Further information on the tolling arrangements is set out in the Dublin Port Tunnel Toll Bye-Laws, copies of which may be downloaded from Transport Infrastructure Ireland's website (<https://www.tii.ie/roads-tolling/tolling-information/statutory-notice>).

<b>Southbound</b> (Santry to Dublin Port)	<b>€10.00</b> between 6.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m., Monday to Friday. <b>€3.00</b> at all other times and on public holidays
<b>Northbound</b> (Dublin Port to Santry)	<b>€10.00</b> between 4.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m., Monday to Friday. <b>€3.00</b> at all other times and on public holidays

### 2023 MAXIMUM TOLLS

In accordance with the Bye-Laws for the Dublin Port Tunnel, Transport Infrastructure Ireland is obliged to publish details of Maximum Tolls as defined in the Bye-Laws. The calculated Maximum Tolls for 2023 are as follows and are provided for information only:
